### Itinerary:

Feb 9-10	Arrival in Quito (2800 m), nights Hotel Sebastian
Feb 11	Yanacocha (temperate forest, 3400 m) and Nono Mindo Ecoroute (upper subtropics, 3400-1750 m) to Tandayapa Bird Lodge. Night Tandayapa
Feb 12	Upper and Lower Tandayapa Valley (subtropics, 1750-2300 m). Night Tandayapa
Feb 13	Milpe Bird Sanctuary (upper foothills, 1100 m) and Mirador Rio Blanco tanager feeders. Afternoon Nono Road. Night Tandayapa.
Feb 14	Mashpi (upper foothills, 1200-1350 m,) and Chontal Oilbird Cave. Night Tandayapa
Feb 15	Rio Silanche (lower foothills, 350-400 m). Afternoon Sachatamia Lodge and Nono Rd. Night Tandayapa
Feb 16	Refugio Paz de las Aves (upper subtropics, 1900 m), return to Quito by way of Calacalí (dry interandean scrub, 2800 m). Night Hotel Sebastian.
Feb 17	Antisana Ecological Reserve (páramo, 3000-3800 m). Night Hotel Sebastian.
Feb 18	Transfer to airport. Flights home.

### Notes:

Weather: Rainy and foggy at Yanacocha and on the Nono Road the first day. After that, generally cloudy in the morning with showers in the late afternoon, rain at night.
